Who are we?

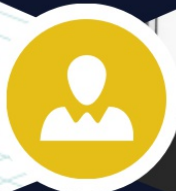
The Ontario Drug Policy Research Network (ODPRN) is a team of researchers who work with a variety of groups within Ontario to research drug safety.
