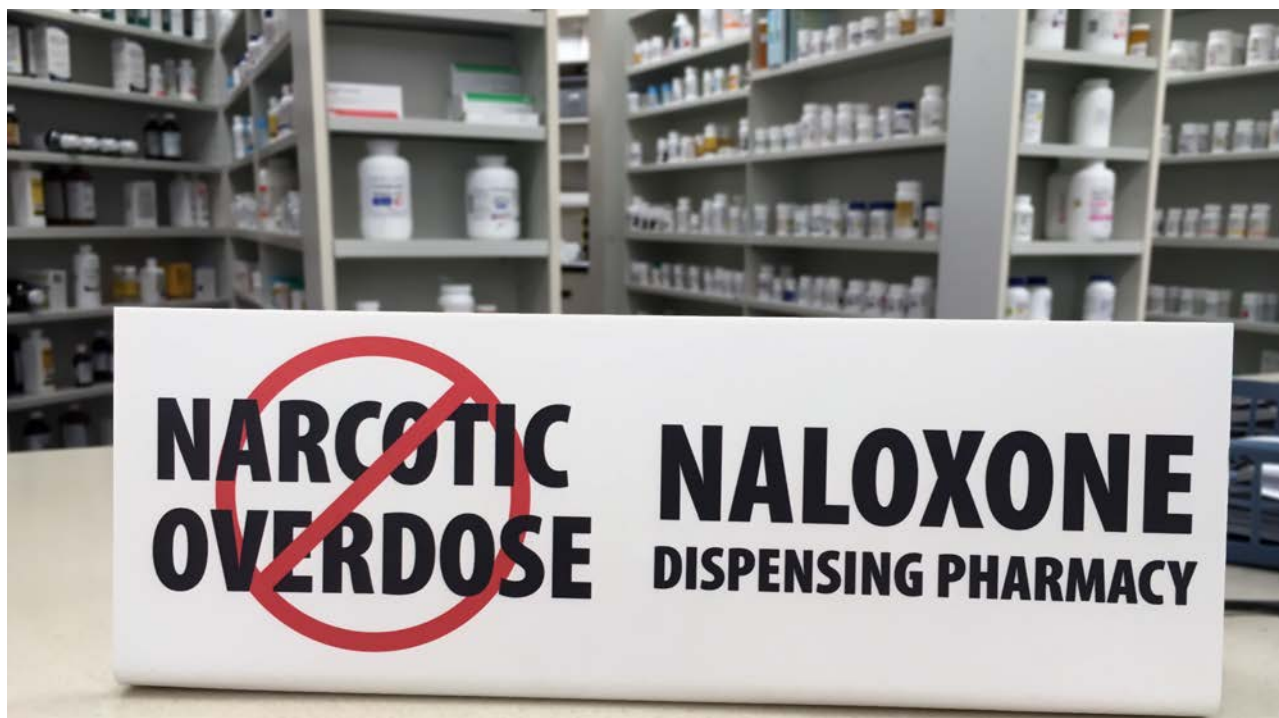


How accessible is naloxone to you?
